<u>Fulton County Delinquent Letters</u>: As of this date, 464 letters will be sent to Fulton County property owners with delinquent parcels. Total delinquent parcels: 649.

<u>Salvage Equipment Sale Update</u>: The District has some salvage equipment that will be put up for sale. The equipment will be set up at the campground near the horseshoe courts. We are waiting for a couple more pieces. Once they arrive, a sale date will be announced and list of sale items will be posted in the paper.

<u>Commissioner Resume Timeline Extended</u>: Commissioner Waggoner announced that resumes to fill the vacant Commissioner position will be now accepted through January 22, 2021. (The original deadline was January 15, 2021.)

Agenda Item # 6 YTD Income Report

Floor was turned over the GM David Webb for the financial report.

As of 12/31/2020: Current Assessment Income Sharp County: \$1,484,095; Fulton County: \$598,366. Total Current: \$2,082,461. Delinquent Sharp County: \$164,457; Fulton County: \$109,256. Total Delinquent: \$273,713. Total Assessment Income: \$2,356,174.

Other Income: Recreational Facilities: \$265,062, Interest Income: \$6,731, All Other Income: \$115,581. Total Other Income: \$387,374.

Through 12/31/2020, total expenditures were \$2,505,083, which is 92.57% of the projected budget with 100.00% of the year passed.

Agenda Item #7 Property Owner Comments

Commissioner Waggoner opened the floor to questions or comments:

Question was asked about the payment for fire hydrants: Do we rent them? Are we buying new ones? Commissioner Waggoner explained that the monthly payment of \$14,480 is made as part of a contract between the Water Company and the District that was entered into years ago.

A follow up question was posed: Does the fire department maintain the hydrants, and do they keep records? David Webb commented that the water company maintains the hydrants. Within the last four months, the fire department and water company began working together to test the hydrants for water flow and pressure. They are marked with different color discs which represent specific flow and pressure. He added that the ISO rating in Cherokee Village was lowered due to the new efforts.

An inquiry was made asking if there is a breakdown to the financials that David reports each month. David answered that the numbers are posted on our website within the Commissioners Meetings Minutes each month. A more detailed breakdown can be requested.
