2. That no part of said lands aforesaid lie within the boundaries of a municipality (meaning a city of the first class, city of the second class or an incorporated town).

3. That the lands embraced in the proposed suburban improvement district are located in two counties, namely, Sharp County, Arkansas, and Fulton County, Arkansas, and the greater portion of said lands are located in Sharp County, Arkansas, and for such reason this Court has jurisdiction of the subject of this petition.

4. That the proposed suburban improvement district be laid off, organized and formed for the following specific purposes:

a. To open, grade, drain, pave, curb, gutter or otherwise improve streets, roads, highways, and every other way for passage and use of vehicles, including viaducts and underpasses, either within or without the boundaries of the district if the property of the district will be benefited thereby, and such purpose shall include the acquisition of rights of ways by purchase or the exercise of the power of eminent domain, and to maintain such streets, roads, highways, and every other way, for passage and use by vehicles, lying within the boundaries of the district or beyond the boundaries of the district if the property of the district will be benefited thereby;

b. To build, purchase or accept as a gift recreational facilities such as, but not limited to, parks, lakes, golf courses, playgrounds, clubhouses, stadiums, auditoriums, arts and craft centers, folklore centers, interpretive centers, camping areas, green belt areas and any other facilities to provide for the recreation and cultural needs of the owners of the lands within the district, and also to care for and

maintain and operate any such recreational facilities;

c. To establish, equip and maintain a rural fire department, including construction of fire department buildings, purchase of fire

trucks, fire boats and other firefighting equipment.

5. That in furtherance of the purposes for which the district is proposed that such district shall have all of the authority and all of the powers as provided under and pursuant to the provisions Act No. 41, of the Acts of Arkansas for 1941, as amended, and without limiting the foregoing, that such proposed district have the following specific authority and powers, to-wit:

a. In aid and furtherance of the purposes set forth in paragraph numbered 4 hereof, that such proposed district shall have the authority and powers to hire managers and other employees and to pay their salaries incident to the operation and maintenance of any of the improvements and facilities set forth in paragraph numbered 4 hereof, and shall also have the authority and powers to acquire and purchase equipment and machinery incident to the operation and maintenance of such facilities, and shall be further authorized and empowered to do any and all other acts which shall be deemed necessary in order to purchase, construct, accept as a gift, operate and maintain any and all improvements and facilities as set forth in paragraph numbered 4 hereof;

b. In aid and furtherance of the purposes set forth in paragraph numbered 4 hereof, that such proposed district shall have the authority and powers to sell or lease any improvement owned by it to any adjacent or nearby municipality (nearby municipality shall mean a municipality within 10 miles of any boundary of the district), or to an improvement district therein, or to public service corporations serving on behalf of the property owners of the district and to make contracts with inhabitants of nearby municipalities

(as above defined);

c. In aid and furtherance of the purposes set forth in paragraph numbered 4 hereof, that such proposed district shall have the authority and powers to accept as a gift any and all of the improvements and facilities set forth in paragraph numbered 4 hereof, upon the assumption of the maintenance and operation of such improvements and facilities, and shall have the authority and powers to effect the assessment of benefits and to levy the necessary tax against such assessment of benefits, in order to provide the revenue for the costs of such maintenance and operation.

6. That JOHN A. COOPER, JR., JOE N. BASORE, AND JIM NAPPER, three property owners of said proposed district, be

appointed commissioners of said district.

7. That the proposed district be named Cherokee Village Road and Street, Recreational and Fire Department Suburban Improvement District No. 1.

8. That the Court take any and all other action which may be necessary or appropriate to effect the purposes of this petition.

9. That this petition is one of a number of identical petitions, except as to signatures, signed by other record owners of the within described lands and all such petitions together represent a single document which is the petition of all of the signing record owners.
